

The wines on this list, in our cellar and in our shop, Eli's List are selected because they match the fundamental criteria we have set for ourselves.

All of the wines are chosen for their ability to express provenance, terroir and tradition. We look for wines that remain pure, through natural, sustainable, organic and/or biodynamic production methods. These are wines that have an integrity and elegance that speaks to us. Our preference is for old-world wines and within that range we narrowly focus on the wines of Bourgogne, Champagne and Piemonte. What makes us love these small patches of precious earth?

We love the Pinot Noir grape and Burgundy and Champagne both use it predominantly while Piemonte is about the Nebbiolo grape, very similar to Pinot Noir but with a bit more tannin. All three of these regions make wines that need to be aged for quite a while to express their potential and while we don't usually love waiting, the tension and excitement created by anticipation is part of the thrill here. All three regions are waging a battle between modern and traditional wine making methods they understand the meaning of terroir and its impact on the wine produced and all are heavily committed to Organic and Biodynamic farming practices.

Sherry

Fino Superiore "En Rama" Bodegas Mons Urium, Jerez, Spain 12 glass
(Palomino Fino) Classic, using the traditional solera system and typical velo de flor, layer of yeast that protects the wine. Soils of albariza, white marl, clay, calcium & sea fossils, traditionally farmed.

Sparkling

Champagne "Blanc des Blancs Brut" Saint-Chamant, Champagne, France 20 glass
(Chardonnay) A champagne whose fruit comes mostly from Chouilly, a grand cru in the Cotes-des-Blancs. Began in 1930 with the intention of producing traditional and aged champagne. Farming is sustainable.

Vino Spumante "Tajad Cuvee Brut" Le Vigne di Alice, Veneto, Italia 12 glass
(Glera, Verdiso & Boschera) This is grower prosecco. A prosecco that is made not by an industry and collecting mass produced grapes, but by a family, a woman who hand picks and farms organically. The soil is of glacial moraine origin, chalky, rocky, lean, and rich in minerals.

Whites

2011 Bourgogne Pierre Morey, Burgundy, France 9 half 18 glass
(Chardonnay) The wines of Pierre Morey are famous for their pure craftsmanship. Each wine displays Morey's impressive signature of elegance. Oak is used only in a supporting role to frame and highlight the fruit character, elegance and balance. These vines are all from Meursault in deep soils of clay and limestone and biodynamically farmed.

2012 Pouilly-Loché "Clos des Rocs Monopole" Clos des Rocs, Burgundy, France 10 half 20 glass
(Chardonnay) Just north of the famous vineyards of Pouilly-Fuisse are the delicious terroirs of the Pouilly-Loché. According to Neal Rosenthal, the importer, this may be the first time this appellation has appeared in the United States. These wines are characterized by their limestone and red clay soils. The wines are a bit more precise than those of Fuisse but with amazing length and elegance. 70 year old vines and follow organic practices.

2012 Pouilly-Fume "Vieilles Vignes" Regis Minet, Loire, France 7 half 14 glass
(Sauvignon Blanc) Pouilly-sur-Loire produces one of the greatest sauvignon blancs in the world. Regis' vineyards sit at 750 feet, surrounded by hills on the far east of the Loire river and centered on the limestone and clay of the Kimmeridgian chain. The scattered flint in these vineyards imbues the whites a character quite distinctive from the neighboring village of Sancerre.

2013 Muscadet Côtes de Grand Lieu "La Noë Sur Lie" Eric Chevalier, Loire, France 6 half 12 glass
(Melon de Bourgogne) Eric Chevalier took over his family's estate, Domaine l'Aujardiere, in 2005 and since has been making extremely excellent muscadet. This is 4 hectare plot of pure granite that is located on the western side of the city of Nantes. The vines are on average 40 years old, with some that are 60 years old, and all farming is sustainable. Aged on its lees for 8-10 months.

2011 Toscana "Palistori" Tenuta di Valgiano, Lucca, Tuscany, Italy 9 half 18 glass
(Based on Vermentino) This wine is named Palistori after the rocks that hold together the soil and the vines. The farming has always been organic and biodynamic here and the wines are testaments to the soils of Tuscany. This is vermentino predominantly with 10% of the vermentino aged in oak and blended with malvasia and trebbiano.

2013 Vinho Regional Lisboa "Antonio" Casal Figueira, Lisbon, Portugal 8 half 15 glass
(Vital) This wine comes from four vineyards that sit high, 200 to 450 meters above sea level, in Serra de Montejunto, the hills surrounding Lisbon. It is made from biodynamically farmed Vital grapes in soils of limestone. The wine sees oak, 8 months in a mix of barrels and has an uncanny resemblance to Chenin Blanc.

Selections by the Glass

Rosé

2014 Luberon "Le Chataignier" Domaine de la Citadelle, Rhone, France 6 half 12 glass
(Based on Cinsault) This rosé is a beautiful wine from the Luberon in the Rhone valley, south eastern France. The winery focuses on organic production and vineyard maintenance is carried out by hand and plough. Here the four varietals, mostly cinsault with a bit of grenache, syrah & carignan are grown in limestone.

Reds

2012 Bourgogne Roncevie Domaine Arlaud, Gevrey Chambertin, Burgundy France 9 half 18 glass
(Pinot Noir) "Roncevie" is truly an insider Burgundy secret and a top value for those in the know. The vineyard sits surrounded by Gevrey village vineyards, and neighbors grand cru Mazoyeres-Chambertin. Always a blockbuster and a wine that delivers far above its "simple" status.

2011 Châteauneuf du Pape Domaine Jean Royer, Rhone, France 10 half 20 glass
(Grenache, Syrah) The Royer family has been farming winegrapes in Chateauneuf du Pape since the 1800s. More specifically, they have been growing grapes in the very best parts in the southern sector of this historic area. Today Royer is making his wines from about 12 hectares of vines in the prestigious areas of Bois de la Ville, Les Grandes Serres, and recently a very small portion of La Crau located next to Rayas.

2012 Bourgueil "Franc de Pied" Catherine et Pierre Breton, Loire Valley, France 9 half 17 glass
(Cabernet Franc) The Bretons farm eleven hectares of vines just east of Bourgueil in the village of Restigne. They have become international icons for the natural wine movement in an area where the climate and soil can make organic viticulture difficult. Franc de Pied is a bottling done from the Breton's one parcel of un-grafted cabernet franc vines.

2008 Coteaux du Giennois "Biaul" Mathieu Coste, Loire Valley, France 8 half 16 glass
(Based on Gamay) From just north of Sancerre, this appellation is fairly recent, since 1998. Clay soils with some limestone rocks, called "tete de chat". This wine was bottled after spending 5 years in large concrete vats. Mathieu took over this domaine in 1998 and not treated since 1982. The wine is a blend of Pinot Noir and Gamay.

1997 Langhe S. Guglielmo Malvirá, Piemonte, Italia 10 half 20 glass
(Barbera, Nebbiolo, Bonarda) This vineyard is very special, and is Malvira's most historic vineyard as it was the property of Roberto and Massimo's grandparents on their mother's side. San Guglielmo shares a border with Malvira's Trinità vineyard and has always been planted with Barbera, Bonarda, and Nebbiolo. The exposition of the vineyard faces south, measures 3 hectares and the soil is a blend of calcareous clay and sand.

2006 Gattinara Nervi, Piemonte, Italia 9 half 18 glass
(Nebbiolo) Gattinara is located north of the famous vineyards of Barolo and Barbaresco. Nebbiolo is still used but referred to as spanna here. The soils of Gattinara have a higher proportion of sand make this version of nebbiolo more elegant and fresh. Nervi is traditional estate and although has a new owner has continued to make very traditional styled wines. This is from vineyards in Molsino, Valferana, Garavoglie and Casaccie.

2012 Vino de Madrid "Navaherreros" Bernabeleva, Madrid, Spain 8 half 16 glass
(Garnacha) Bernabeleva is an organic and biodynamic estate that is located in San Martin, outside of Madrid. They are making Garnacha in large wood casks, using indigenous yeasts and long macerations. This is the tinto which is grown at 700 meters above sea level in granite and sand and ages in old French barriques.

2012 Finger Lakes "Dry Riesling" Herman Weimer, New York, United States of America 6 half 12 glass

Vintage Selections by the Glass

The following section is a group of vintage wines that we offer by the glass as well as bottle. We are able to offer these wines by the glass using the Coravin decanting system. The Coravin injects a needle through the cork and slowly extracts wine while replacing it with argon gas which protects the wine from air and preserves what is still in the bottle for as long as a month.

Whites

2006 Sancerre Sauvage Pascal Jolivet, Loire, France 13 half 25 glass
(Sauvignon Blanc) Pascal Jolivet is a young vigneron that has been changing the loire valley over the past few years. He has begun with Sauvage to bottle one vineyard site as a Grand Cru would be. This is Sauvignon Blanc from a vineyard in Champtin of calcereous soils. It is aged sur lie and bottled without filtration.

2004 Pouilly-Vinzelles Les Quarts La Soufrandiere / Bret Brothers, France 13 half 25 glass
(Chardonnay) The Bret Brothers took over their father's vineyards La Soufrandiere and now make organic and biodynamic wines of the highest quality. They produce many wines from the different villages that dot the Cote-Chalonnaise. This is particularly good because it has the length and body of Pouilly-Fuisse but adds an extra tone of minerality from Vinzelles. This Lieu-Dit, Les Quarts, is special to the brothers. As they say the clay and limestone soils are "alive" and the southern exposure is "magical." It is fermented and aged 11 months in barrel.

2004 IGT Venezia Giulia Anfora Josko Gravner, Friuli, Italy 18 half 36 glass
(Ribolla Gialla) Gravner is perhaps Italy's greatest vigneron. This is his classic skin macerated white. Gravner is a champion of his local varietal ribolla gialla and ages it in amphora. These clay pots from Georgia are buried and the earth controls the temperature of the wine making process. A real treat.

1999 Colli Orientali del Friuli-Cialla Ciallabianco Ronchi di Cialla, Friuli, Italy 18 half 35 glass
(Ribolla Cialla, Verduzzo Friulano & Picolit) Ronchi di Cialla has been producing organic and natural wine since the 1970's. They are the only owners of the appellation "Cialla". So this is a monopole and of only varieties found in Friuli. This is aged in oak for 12 months and is primarily ribolla gialla. 1999 was an amazing vintage throughout Italy and especially here at Cialla.

1995 IGT Lazio Botte 45 Fiorano, Lazio, Italy 15 half 30 glass
(Malvazia Candida) Prince Boncompagni Ludovisi was the original owner of the property outside Rome where he farmed vines that were the first to see organic farming in all of Italy. The prince cared so much about his vines that he would not let anyone to farm these as he got older nor could any one buy the property. This remains some of the last bottles he made before his death.

1981 Rioja Grand Reserva Blanca Vina Tondonia Lopez de Heredia, Rioja, Spain 25 half 50 glass
(Viura & Macabeo) Lopes de Heredia is one of Rioja's star estates. They are focused on producing traditional and organic wines. They also have an amazing philosophy of holding wine back and ageing it until it is ready, as is the case here. This is a recently released 1981 white Rioja. Aged 10 years barrel and stored at the estate in bottle for the rest of the time.

Reds

2006 Gevrey-Chambertin Domaine Arlaud, Burgundy, France 14 half 28 glass
(Pinot Noir) Cyprien Arlaud strongly believes in keeping the vineyard and wine-making processes as natural as possible. In this vein, they began ploughing the vineyards with horses a decade ago, at the insistence of his sister Bertille, and most of the work is done by hand. These are vines from four vineyards in the lieu-dits of "la Justice" and "les Sevrées". Maceration and ageing in oak, 25% new, resting in that oak for 14 months.

Vintage Selections by the Glass

Reds (continued)

2006 Beaune 1er Cru Les Aigrots Michel Lafarge, Burgundy, France 20 half 40 glass
(Pinot Noir) Domaine Lafarge is a family run estate that specializes in wines from Volnay and Beaune. The majesty of these wines comes from a small unassuming house in Burgundy. Michel Lafarge farms biodynamically and makes some of the most pure expressions of Pinot Noir from the Cotes-de-Beaune. This is from the vineyards which surround the town of Beaune in the Cotes d'Or. This is premier cru with soils of clay and limestone and vinified in old oak barrels.

2006 Cornas Domaine August Clape, Rhone, France 23 half 45 glass
(Syrah) Domaine August Clape was the first to bottle wine in the Northern Rhone region of Cornas. He farms following sustainable practices, uses natural yeasts and punches downs daily. This wine from vineyards of pure granite is aged in 12 hectoliter foudres for 22 months.

2001 Chinon Beaumont Catherine et Pierre Breton, Loire, France 25 half 50 glass
(Cabernet Franc) Breton makes some of the regions best Bourgueil following biodynamic principles. This is his chinon from 60 year old vines in clay and limestone soils. The vines are hand harvested, minimal sulphur added and ageing in oak is in wooden vats and barriques for 1 year.

1999 Colli Orientali del Friuli Schioppettino Ronchi di Cialla, Friuli, Italy 18 half 35 glass
(Schioppettino) Ronchi di Cialla is the 1 of 3 estates that carry their own appellation. Schioppettino is a native red varietal to Friuli, known as Ribolla Nera. It produces light, mineral driven wines. Here the aging was for just a little over a year in barrel and the rest of the time in bottle. 1999 was an amazing vintage throughout Italy and especially here at Cialla.

1994 Rioja Tinto Vina Tondonia Lopez de Heredia, Rioja, Spain 18 half 35 glass
(Tempranillo, Garnacha, Graciano & Mazuelo) Lopez de Heredia is one of Rioja's star estates. They are focused on producing traditional and organic wines. They also have an amazing philosophy of holding wine back and aging it until it is ready, as is the case here. This is a recently released 1994, excellent vintage, Rioja Gran Reserva. Aged 10 years barrel and stored at the estate in bottle for the rest
